Terms and Conditions

The City of Enid agrees to the following terms:

- Provide litter bags and safety vests.
- Pick up filled litter bags
- Furnish and install two Adopt-A-Street signs (one for each direction of traffic) with the Adopter's name on each sign.

The volunteer group named _____, hereinafter called the "Group," recognize the need and the desirability of litter-free highways are entering this Agreement to permit the group to contribute toward the effort of maintaining litter-free highways and streets.

By signature below, the Group acknowledges the hazardous nature of the work and agrees to the following terms and conditions:

- Participants in the Group agree to obey and abide by all laws and regulations relating to safety and such terms and conditions as may be required by the Adopt-A-Street program Coordinator, the City Street Supervisor, for such special conditions on a particular adopted section.
- When participants are 16 years of age or younger, the Group shall furnish adequate supervision using one adult for every eight young participants.
- Children under 16 years of age should not be present at pickup site.
- Each Group shall conduct at least two safety meetings per year. Participants must sign a hold harmless agreement and attend a safety meeting conducted by the group before participating in a cleanup.
- Groups shall pick up on one side of the road at a time.
- Groups shall park all vehicles well clear of roadway and at least ten feet from shoulder.
- Groups shall adopt a section of roadway that is at least one mile long.
- Groups shall be required to pick up litter at least four times per year for a minimum two-year period.
- The Group shall be required to pick up all litter whenever the appearance of the adopted section warrants it.
- The Group shall obtain required supplies and materials from the Department during business hours.
- Participating organizations must coordinate their pick up schedules with the City to prevent conflicts over the use of the street frontage and proposed construction work. Two week notice prior to a scheduled pick up event is required.
